#### **DESCRIPTION**


Lolland's northern coastline borders the waters of Småland, with its many islands. The coast, the islands and the water are the setting for extraordinarily beautiful natural scenery.

The bicycle route 'The Islands by Bike' takes you along the north coast of Lolland, between Bandholm and Kragenæs, and over the three largest islands in the waters of Småland; Femø, Fejø and Askø.

From Kragenæs there is a ferry connection to Femø and Fejø, and there is a small ferry from Bandholm to Askø. In addition to the beautiful scenery, you will discover that the three islands are peaceful and idyllic. Relaxation is guaranteed, as the hustle and bustle of everyday life is left behind.

The mild island climate provides perfect conditions for producing apples, apple juice and cider. The islands are particularly beautiful in the springtime, when all the fruit trees are blossoming.

Askø is the smallest of the three islands, with no point on the island higher than four metres above sea level. Femø is the most hilly island, and its winding roads and paths are best explored by bike, or on foot.



Accommodation is available on all three islands, making it convenient to split the route up over several days.

### INFO

The bicycle route is signposted with blue signs - you just need to follow the ferry symbols.

Along the bicycle route, you will also encounter signs with symbols and numbers from other routes; The Munk Road' (89), 'Explore Naturlandet' (N), 'The Lollandian Alps' (mountains) and 'Bicycle Safari' (rhinoceros).

We recommend following the route in the direction that follows the numbers on the map. The entire length of the bicycle route is signposted in this direction.

Refreshments available on all three islands as well as Kragenæs and Bandholm.

#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

You can start the bicycle route at Kragenæs or Bandholm Harbour. You can get to and from the harbours with a bus. Your bicycle can be brought on the bus. Alternatively, start your tour by riding from Maribo to Bandholm on the 'Bicycle Safari' route.

Naturlandet recommends Rejseplanen.dk for bus and train schedules.

# **RENT A BIKE**

Bikes can be hired from the grocery store in Kragenæs and at the Bandholm Hotel.

# **VISITING PRIVATE PROPERTY**

This bicycle route passes through a private forest, owned by Knuthenlund Estate.

When visiting private areas, please observe the following rules:

- Access permitted in private forests from 6 am until sunset.
- Access only permitted on paths and roads. For example, you cannot walk into the forest to eat your lunch pack.
- Collecting mushrooms and berries only permitted if you can reach them from the road.

#### **EXPERIENCES**

# 1 Kragenæs Harbour

Idyllic marina and campground on the shores of the waters of Småland, with regular ferry connections to Femø and Fejø. Close to 'Dodekalitten' and the hills of Ravnsby Bakker. Check the bicycle route 'The Lollandian Alps' if you want to explore this beautiful landscape.

#### 2 Femø

50 minutes with the ferry from Kragenæs. Femø is best known for its annual women's camp, and for the Femø Jazz Festival. Femø has a small museum and plenty of other points of interest as well as beautiful scenery. See how many of the characteristic green benches you can find on your way around the island.

#### 3 Fejø

Just 15 minutes away with the ferry from Kragenæs, Fejø has one of Denmark's oldest island churches, as well as Fejø Mill, Sletteren Strand beach and the island of Skalø, which is connected to Fejø with a small dam wall.

#### **4 Blans Harbour**

A lovely little harbour, one of the smallest on Lolland's northern coast. The harbour is beautifully placed in a bay surrounded by nature.

#### **5 Bandholm Harbour**

The largest harbour on Lolland's northern coast, it is an industrial and ferry harbour as well as a marina. There is a regular ferry connection to Askø. Bandholm Harbour also has a swimming beach, harbour bath and a promenade on the pier from which you can see irresistible sunsets.

25 minutes by ferry from Bandholm. Enjoy your picnic on Østerhoved or Lilleø. Visit the museum, the church and the Askø Krukkeri pottery shop. Meet the local island dwellers at the grocery store.

On Femø, Fejø and Askø you will find several accommodation options as well as dining and shopping facilities. Check the "Naturlandet" app. When you have opened a map, you can then turn on the filters that you require.




